

There is power in prayer!

(Jam 5:15-16) *“and the prayer offered in faith will restore the one who is sick, and the Lord will raise him up, and if he has committed sins, they will be forgiven him. Therefore, confess your sins to one another, and pray for one another so that you may be healed. The effective prayer of a righteous man can accomplish much.”*



Do not lose heart but pray!

(Luk 18:1-8) *“Now He was telling them a parable to show that at all times they ought to pray and not to lose heart, saying, "In a certain city there was a judge who did not fear God and did not respect man. There was a widow in that city, and she kept coming to him, saying, 'Give me legal protection from my opponent.' "For a while he was unwilling; but afterward he said to himself, 'Even though I do not fear God nor respect man, yet because this widow bothers me, I will give her legal protection, otherwise by continually coming she will wear me out.' And the Lord said, "Hear what the unrighteous judge *said; now, will not God bring about justice for His elect who cry to Him day and night, and will He delay long over them? "I tell you that He will bring about justice for them quickly. However, when the Son of Man comes, will He find faith on the earth?"*

A paraphrase of Isaiah 40:28

(Isaiah 40:28) *Don't you know anything? Haven't you been listening? GOD doesn't come and go. God lasts. He's Creator of all you can see or imagine. He doesn't get tired out, doesn't pause to catch his breath. And he knows everything, inside and out.*

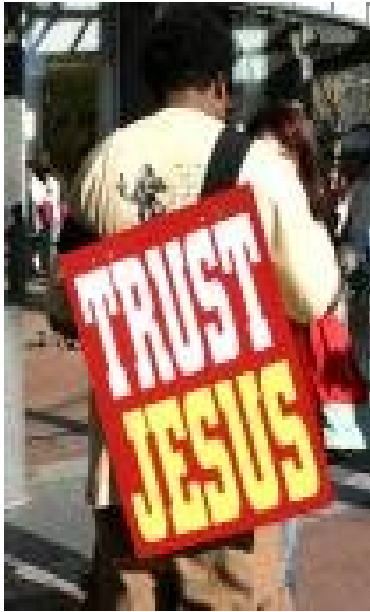


God knows!

God is Omnipotent, Omnipresent, and Omniscient. This means that He is all Powerful, ever Present in all places at all times, and all Knowing. While the devil works to destroy, he does not have the attributes or nature of God. Although he has power, the devil is limited and not all powerful, ever present, or all knowing like our God. No matter what time of the day, circumstance, or need, God is ever present in your situation. He knows what you need and when you need it. And never forget, that He is able to accomplish whatever concerns you at all times with His awesome and unlimited power.

Only believe.

(Isaiah 55:6) *“Seek the LORD while He may be found; Call upon Him while He is near.”*



Before you can really trust Jesus, God the Father and the Holy Spirit, you must know Them. The Bible tell us that in **Hebrews 11:6**. *“And without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is and that He is a rewarder of those who seek Him.”* Perhaps this paraphrase of Hebrews will help. **Hebrews 11:6** *“It's impossible to please God apart from faith. And why? Because anyone who wants to approach God must believe both that He exists and that he cares enough to respond to those who seek him.”*

Trust, Faith, Believing, all mean the same thing. For those of us who know God we know that He is trustworthy, faithful, and we believe in Him. For those who do not really know God, all they have to do is seek Him with all of their hearts and He will reveal Himself to them. The path to God is through His Word, the Bible. Be bold IN SEEKING, and humble IN HIS PRESENCE, at the same time. Read what God has revealed about Himself and those who will put their trust in Him.

Ask for prayer from a believer

(Matthew 7:7) *“Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it will be opened.”*



The above promise is for believers. Sometimes all of us need the prayer of agreement and help from another Christian. This is part of our calling and mission on the earth. Never be embarrassed to ask for a prayer partner. If you do not know God, find a Christian and ask them to pray with you to help you on your journey and discovery of God.

The Power of the prayer of agreement.

(Matthew 18:19-20) *“Again I say to you, that if two of you agree on earth about anything that they may ask, it shall be done for them by My Father who is in heaven. For where two or three have gathered together in My name, I am there in their midst.”*



Another promise of God to believers is what will happen when they put aside their differences and agree in prayer. Stir up the gift of God inside of you. Look at other believers with the eyes of Jesus, and become part of His active, practicing, and powerful Church. God wants the Body of Christ on earth to accept Him at His Word. When we do, marvelous things, beyond our imaginations will begin to take place for His Glory. Unto Him, shall be the gathering of the people, in this day and in this time.
